





Female Applicants to EU 27 Member States (2008-2011)





Whilst the number of female asylum applicants from FGM-practising countries remained relatively **constant** from 2008-2011, the total number of female applicants to EU 27 **increased.**



All countries have experienced an increase in applications since 2009, except **Sweden** and the **Netherlands**


% of female applicants from FGM-practising countries out of total female applicants (2008-2011)









Recognition Rate for Females from FGM-risk Countries in Top EU 7 MS




EU Member States where refugee girls and women from FGM-practising countries settle





Where do refugee girls under 14 from FGMpractising countries of origin settle in the EU?




Number of girls granted international protection




Only 10 EU MS granted international protection to girls under-14 from FGM-risk countries during this period

The UK granted protection to 500 girls out of total 915


Which countries of origin did the girls come from?

Recommendations

- Need for <u>country</u>- and <u>community-tailored</u> strategies to address FGM
- Need for EU and national policies to address specific vulnerabilities of:
- women and girl asylum-seekers with FGM in reception centres and in communities
 - refugee girls and women with FGM integrating in EU
- refugee girls potentially intact in communities (prevention and protection)
- Need for enhanced gender-sensitivity and capacity in asylum system:
- Developing training material (EAC) to support adjudication of asylum claims on grounds of FGM + gender-sensitive COI
 - Enhancing gender-sensitive asylum procedure
 - Procedural and substantive Guidelines on FGM
- Enhancing skills of health practitioners in reception centres and communities
- Gathering enhanced statistical data
