

The data collection methodology was designed for project monitoring purposes, and there might be differences in the reporting practices.

























- Rich data: over 600 journals written by 30 counsellors in 6 countries over a period of a year
- Deep insights: into the experiences of women and why women were not receiving assistance & challenges in assistance







