 - Victim Support Morocco from Morocco







National meetings

- Hungary (June 2023): Discussions with Feher Gyuru and MoJ for the establishment of cooperation of NGOs and governmental services and for setting up the 116006 helpline
- Belgium (June 2023): Belgian national pshychotrauma coordination meeting at the MoH with 40 representatives of the country
- Serbia (September 2023): Victimology Society of Serbia and experts on supporting families and children victims of the mass shooting in May 2023
- Lithuania (November 2023): Accreditation of Victim Support Services + 116006, online meeting

Standards and accreditation

- Development of supporting documents for self-accreditation procedure full members
- Aim to have every full member accredited in the next couple of years
- APAV and Victim Support England & Wales have started the process
